Many tournaments have their own established domain names in their cups that other clubs are well aware of. Examples of domain names are **Arenacup.com**, **Summercup.com** or **Springtournament.com**

When a cup is created in ProCup, a link is created that is completely different from your domain name. Automatic connection between your domain name and ProCup does not take place.

ProCup can offer you a domain name linked to the ProCup cup link. We are responsible for buying and registering the domain name and pointing it towards your tournament. More information can be found here:

Option A (quick and easy):

Post the meta tag below in www.testcup.com

Option B (recommended):

This option requires that your domain is secure and encrypted. That is, it has https:// as protocol. Not http://.

If you do not have it encrypted, only option A can be used.
