Here we look at three scenarios for covid-19 custom timing securing that as few teams as possible are active at the same time in the tournament.

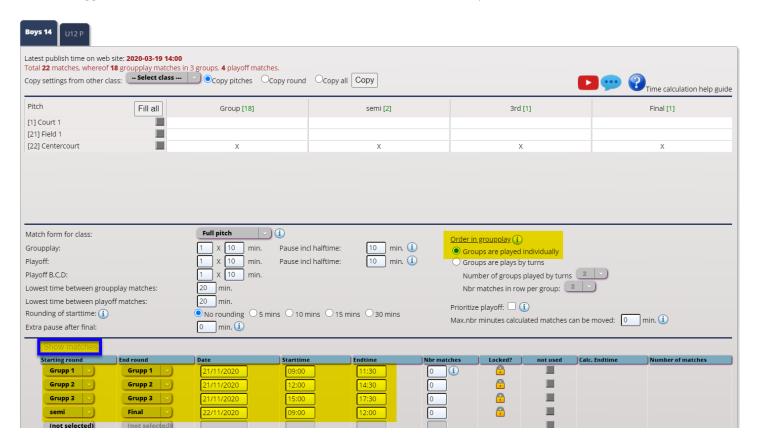
The basic principle is that one or two groups finish playing their matches and then comes the next one or two groups.

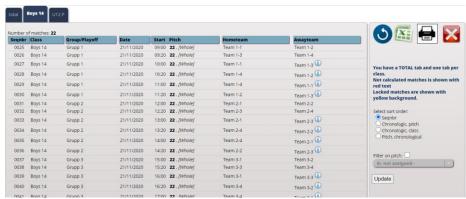
Scenario 1

Set playing time and minimal break between matches (suggestions below) Here you also get suggestions on how to set the different rounds at the bottom of the picture.



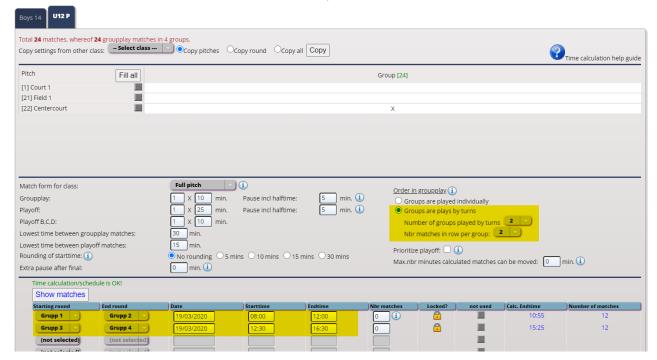

Two classes - 4 groups with 4 teams. Two groups take turns playing their matches.

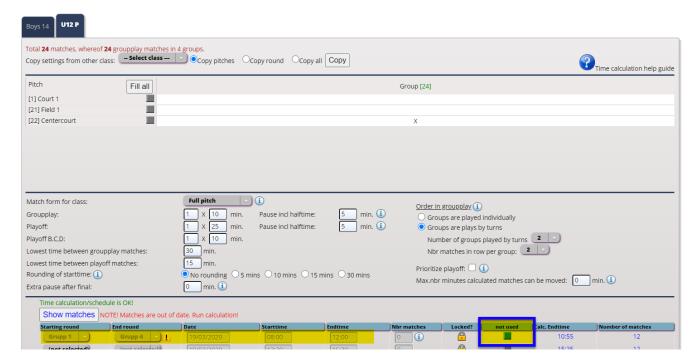
Set playing time and break between matches (suggestions below) Here you also get suggestions on how to set the different rounds at the bottom of the picture
